



IIF Domestic Operations Training Update

Since May 2006, **IIF Data Solutions, Inc. (IIF)** and our partners have planned, developed and subsequently delivered or supported 288 Domestic Operations centric classes and exercises (e.g., JOC 101, JOC Advanced, J3 DOMS, J2 DSCA, J1 DSCA, LNO TTT, ABS/DSC Seminars, All-Hazards CPXs) to over 6,800 Soldiers, Airmen and civilian students from all 54 States and Territories and many federal, state and local mission partners.

Our training and exercise support services are continuously progressing due to the uniqueness of each state and territory and the ever-evolving DSCA threats, concepts, doctrine, regulatory guidance and lessons learned. **All courses and exercises are uniquely tailored to the individual organization or state** in terms of objectives, time and content. Our unique Domestic Operations training and exercise support services include the following:

- **Joint Operation Planning Process (JOPP) Seminar:** Designed and facilitated in September 2014 for the ALNG, the JOPP Seminar is an example of how we can support a complex planning event for a state by developing and facilitating a planning workshop tailored to meet very specific objectives. For the ALNG, it was taking the planning for a “complex catastrophe” to the next level.
- **DSCA Liaison Officer (LNO) Course:** This course continues to be very well received and is tailored from 1 to 3 days, focused on training either the state’s DSCA LNOs or training the state’s LNO trainers (Train-the-Trainer) as they build or mature their own LNO training program. In the past few months we conducted very successful DSCA LNO Courses for the SCNG and FLNG.
- **Advanced Joint Operations Center (JOC) Workshop:** This is a true JOC Operator’s workshop, focusing on the roles and responsibilities of each of the critical JOC operational staff positions, JOC core functions and maturation of your state JOC’s Standard Operating Procedures (SOP). It is tailored to meet the Command’s specific needs as identified by the staff in a “Pre-Workshop Survey” and includes a uniquely tailored JOC Exercise to further develop, test and validate the JOC’s concept of operations. Most recently, we conducted very productive workshops for the UTNG, CANG and the MONG.
- **JOC Basic Course:** This course is tailored to the state/command and is similar to the legacy JOC 101 Course that we developed and taught more than 150 times since 2006. This course is best suited for personnel newly assigned to the JOC and includes a tailored JOC Exercise to reinforce learning. The SCNG and ALNG can attest to the value of the JOC Basic Course as they both recently hosted classes for their respective JOC’s staff.
- **Interstate Deployment Operations for Domestic Response Course:** This course takes a doctrinal approach to domestic Deployment and Redeployment Operations, including the JRSOI segments, tempered with practical application of proven Tactics Techniques and Procedures (TTPs) unique to National Guard Domestic Operations. It includes multiple practical exercises and a capstone Table-Top Exercise (TTX) tailored to the host state. We recently conducted very successful classes for the SCNG and the FLNG.
- **Domestic Readiness Exercise (DRX):** We offer “all-hazards” exercise planning, development and execution. Our support is designed and tailored to meet the state’s specific training objectives. The DRX typically serves to rehearse, test and/or validate current Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) of the JOC and JFHQ’s Battle Staff and may incorporate the Dual Status Command construct. We provide virtual and collaborative environments that replicate real world situations for conducting command post exercises (CPX), table-top exercises (TTX), and full-scale exercises by facilitating exercise control and

white cell augmentation. In 2014, we either developed and executed or supported exercises in AL, NV, HI, FL, and UT. We recently developed and facilitated a dynamic Pandemic Ebola TTX for Joint Task Force Civil Support (JTF-CS).

- **Dual Status Command (DSC) Seminar:** This seminar serves to confirm or refine understanding and concepts regarding the integration of the T10 Deputy Commander & Staff and T10 forces under the state's DSC construct. Participants, at invitation of the supported state, typically include the Adjutant General, JFHQ's senior staff, designated DSC Commanders, the Deputy T-10 Commander and Staff, the Defense Coordinating Officer (DCO) and Staff, FEMA Regional Staff, State Emergency Management leadership and other mission partners. These seminars are extremely beneficial in building the interagency team for the next major disaster or emergency. In the past six months, we conducted very successful DSC Seminars for the UTNG, ALNG and SCNG.
- **CBRN Response Enterprise (CRE) Exercise Support Services:** In 2014, our mobile training teams supported 15 major CRE training events nationwide (TX, FL, AK, NY/NJ, PA, NE, WA, NV, IN, OR, UT) including CERFP and HRF collective training events and evaluations, Vigilant Guard, Patriot and Vibrant Response Exercises and other special focus events. Our services include professional Role Player Support, Incident/Area Command Subject Matter Expertise and SCVS resets and training support.
